Mission

The Javelin is the successor to the Peregrine-class fighter that saw such wide use in the Dominion War of the mid 2370s, improved upon and enhanced to fight threats to the Federation in the 2380s and beyond.

Features

The Javelin is the Federation's first true warp fighter. Though its immediate predecessor, the Peregrine, was also warp-capable, it was limited to a maximum speed of warp 5, necessitating a carrier for long-range operations. The Javelin is equipped with the LF-20 warp drive, allowing it to cruise at warp 7 and achieve speeds as high as warp 9.2 for at least an hour. Though difficult to repair, the Javelin's high warp capability makes it exponentially more versatile than the Peregrine.

The fighter is armed with the revolutionary type VIII micro phaser array and equally impressive enhanced prototype of the Mk 110 micro quantum torpedo launcher, giving the ship the firepower of most other space faring species' cruiser designs. The Javelin's powerful class 4 sensors give it a decided edge in combat, allowing it to scout out hostile assets with relative ease. Defensively, the Javelin is equipped with the FSS-4 regenerative shield grid, allowing the ship to stay in combat much longer than its predecessor, the Peregrine or its contemporary small starship, the Yellowstone.



Background

The Javelin-class fighter is designed to be the preeminent space-superiority design, and through its four years of development, has more than achieved that initial objective. Production began in 2380 with the initial prototype, and with increased tensions with the rising Typhon Pact, Starfleet has found it far easier to recoup its defensive losses in the aftermath of the Borg invasion with the relatively cheap and easy to mass produce Javelin.
